<p>Nomination Deadline</p>	<p>May 1 for Fall semester or Full year November 1 for Spring semester</p> <p>We require all home institution coordinators to officially nominate their exchange students via email to Ms. ZHANG Chao before the deadline.</p>
<p>Student Application Deadline</p>	<p>May 15 for Fall semester or Full year November 15 for Spring semester</p>
<p>List of the documents required for admission</p>	<p>Applicants must apply on ECNU online application system. Application documents must be submitted on the system as required. Documents required for all applicants:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Passport copy • ID photo • Study certificate/highest diploma (Chinese/English version) <p>Other documents may be asked to provide according to program requirements, such as: HSK certificate, and transcripts and so on.</p> <p><i>Application website will be sent to exchange students after the home institution's nomination.</i></p>

Language Requirements	<p>For Chinese language programs, there's no language requirements. For other programs, it's required to provide HSK certificate or English proficiency certificate of different levels: http://xs.ecnu.edu.cn/en/admission/exchange-programs/programs-introduction Generally, HSK level should meet HSK 4~6, English level should meet: TOEFL (85), IELTS (6.0) or B2 level.</p>

Standard Chinese Language Program 17 weeks in total (the orientation week excluded). About two weeks before classes begin, students need to register online and take placement test 2. Global China Program The Global China Program provides an excellent opportunity for students to learn about China through academic and cultural immersion during one semester or one year. The program consists of two parts: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Chinese Language Course (6 credits) from beginning to advanced levels ● English-taught Content Courses (3 credits each) on China Studies and other fields. 3. Visiting Students Program Exchange students will take classes together with ECNU degree students, and receive transcripts upon the completion of the term. Please kindly be noted that most of ECNU majors are given in Chinese. Class settings: Differ from each major All majors offered in the degree program catalogue are open for application. According to the requirements of different departments, applicants may need to conduct an online interview. Chinese-taught programs require different Chinese proficiency level according to different majors. English-taught programs require English proficiency level. Visa information	After being accepted by ECNU, students will be mailed with Admission Notice and DQ form to apply for the X1 visa or X2 visa.
