• Application documents

(The International Relations Offices must send the applications of their students to the following email: lbenitez@uba.ar. The documents must be send in PDF, in a folder with the name of the student)

- Copy of Passport
- Curriculum Vitae
- Learning Agreement
- Transcript of Records
- Certificate of Knowledge of Spanish (Level B2)

Deadlines to recieve applications

- First semester (March-July): Third week of october
- Second semester (August-December): Third week of may

Welcome Kit (Kit de Bienvenida)

The Welcome Kit is a set of useful devices to start your life in Buenos Aires. It includes:

- 40 % of discount in a shuttle from the Airport to the City;
- Special rate in 16 hostels for the firsts nights;
- SIM card for your mobile phone;
- A public transport card (SUBE).
- 20 % of discount in language schools.

You must withdraw in the Ministro Pistarini International Airport (EZE).

Migratory Processes

There are two options to enter Argentina:

- 1) Process the -365 day student visa. Find all the information in the following link: https://www.cancilleria.gob.ar/es/servicios/visas/visa-de-estudiante-365-0
- 2) The immigration policies of the Argentine Republic also give you the possibility to enter in the national territory as a tourist and then modify your immigration category. Once you are in Argentina, you must enter in the following link to start the on-line procedure for temporary residence: http://www.migraciones.gov.ar/radex/index.html

All documentation issued abroad must have the legalization of the Argentine Consulate located in the corresponding country. If the country has ratified the Hague Convention, the document must be legalized by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the home country.
